Change in payment process for Marine Corps League membership dues

Commandants and Paymasters:

There is some confusion regarding the new method of dues payment for the Marine Corps League. I understand that it seems complicated, but once we get through this first year, it will make things much easier for both detachments and the National Headquarters.

Dues have recently been \$30, with \$20 of that going to National, \$4 to the Department, and the balance kept by the Detachment (a few Detachments charge more than \$30 and keep the extra). These dues have historically been paid in the anniversary month of when the member joined the League.

Beginning this year, those with anniversary months up to and including August 2017 will pay prorated dues of \$20 (instead of the previous \$30), with \$10 less going to National, the same \$4 to the Dept., and the balance to the Detachment.

THEN – on Sept. 1, 2017, <u>ALL</u> members will pay \$30 dues that will be good for a year until Sept. 1, 2018 (divided up the same way as it is now). The due date for everyone's dues after that will be Sept. 1 of each year. This will eliminate National having to send out dues notices throughout the year, as everyone's renewal date will be the same.
